



Reproductive Health Care: Concerns and Priorities

- JULY 2024



Methodology

This poll was conducted between June 11-13, 2024 among a sample of 2,201 adults. The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of adults based on age, gender, race, educational attainment, region, gender by age, and race by educational attainment. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 2 percentage points.

Key Takeaways

Reproductive Health Care Is Important: Three-in-four (73%) adults say reproductive rights are an important policy area to them and their family, including half (47%) who say this is a *very important* policy area. The issue is particularly important for women of reproductive age.

Reproductive Health Care Access Is a Concern: Just half (51%) of women of reproductive age are confident they could get an abortion if they needed one—most commonly citing abortion laws in their state (42%) and costs (42%) as the biggest barriers.

- The concern goes well beyond abortion access: three-in-five (60%) adults are concerned about access to birth control in the near future.
- Reproductive Health Policy: Two-thirds (66%) of adults say it is important that Congress pass legislation guaranteeing the right to abortion access in the U.S.

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


Three-in-four (73%) adults say reproductive rights are an important policy area to them and their family, including half (47%) who say this is a *very important* policy area.

Generally speaking, how important are each of the following policy areas to you and your family?




Among women of reproductive age, three-in-five (58%) say reproductive rights are a *very important* policy area to them and their family.

Generally speaking, how important are each of the following policy areas to you and your family?




Similarly, half (51%) of adults who live in a state with protected abortion access are concerned about the future of abortion access in their state.

Just half (51%) of women of reproductive age are confident they could get an abortion if they needed one.

Confidence in being able to get an abortion is much higher among women who live in a state with protected abortion access (67%). See appendix slide 17 for additional details.



Women of reproductive age overwhelmingly say abortion laws in their state (42%) and costs (42%) would be the biggest barriers if they were seeking an abortion.

One-in-four (23%) women of reproductive age don't know whether abortion is currently legal in their state, while half (48%) of those who live in a state with abortion access don't know of their nearest abortion clinic.




Three-in-five (60%) adults are concerned about access to birth control in the near future—a trend consistent across key demographics.

Thinking about recent court rulings, federal and state laws, and other news headlines related to reproductive health laws, how concerned are you, if at all, about access to **birth control** in the near future?




Two-thirds (66%) of adults say it is important that Congress pass legislation guaranteeing the right to abortion access in the U.S, including 42% who say this is *very important*.

How important is it to you that Congress pass legislation guaranteeing the right to abortion access in the U.S.?



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
